Course Description

This course will provide a brief overview of neuroanatomy of the brain and general introduction to psychiatry followed by a specific focus on the major psychiatric disorders. The presentation, etiology, epidemiology, investigations and treatments of patients with bipolar disorder, depression, schizophrenia and anxiety disorders will be described and explained. Pharmacological and non-pharmacological treatments will be covered, as will clinical trial issues. The course will also address the complexities of psychiatric treatment in the ever-increasing elderly population. Video presentations, case studies and practical sessions with rating scales will be inherent throughout this two-day course.
